Agility Trials:

Classes will run 4” and up on Saturday and 24” down on Sunday. Selected & veteran class runs concurrently with their regular class.

Check in will be between 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday and anytime Saturday & Sunday. Only check in once. General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice dogs only immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization. PLEASE have you dog with you at the briefing.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run an hour longer!!! If you have a conflict between agility and conformation, obedience or rally, please let us know and we will do whatever we can to let you and your dog run (we can not however hold up a course change).

Scheduling Conflicts

If you have a conflict between agility, obedience or rally and another event, please let us know and we will do whatever we can to allow you and your dog run (we can not however hold up a course or class change).

Moving Up in Obedience

6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

Moving Up in Rally Obedience

6.7.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

Agility Move-ups & Scribe Sheets

Move-ups for Trial 1 will be accepted until Tuesday, July 27th, 2010. For Trials 2 through 4 move ups will be accepted no later than 15 minutes after the RUN that title was completed in is finished. Exhibitor agility scribe sheet copies are available at gate ringside; please pick them up after each run.

Obedience Correction Match Fri. July 30. Time: 4-8 p.m.

Match to be held in the trial venue, which is indoors and fully matted, 3 walls and 1 gated, regulation obedience ring. Cost is \$12.00 with all proceeds going to Performance Dogs Canada. Order of classes: Novice Open then Utility. Pre-registration is required with preference going to those entered in the trials. As there will be a limit on the numbers, please let us know if you are entered in the trial. To pre-register, please contact Eileen Fisher @ eileenfi@sympatico.ca. We will collect payment on the day of the match. If you book a spot and don't show and don't cancel, you will be required to pay for that spot. We request that you do cancel as we will keep a waiting list. When pre-registering please give Eileen you name, dog's name, class(es), jump heights, email and phone #.

Rally Obedience Show-N-Go

Rally Obedience Show-N-Go (outdoors by agility ring) is on Friday, July 30, at the show site from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Competitors will be allowed 3 minutes in the ring. Course will be at CKC Advanced level. \$10.00 per entry, or 2 runs with same dog for \$16. Food, toys and leashes are allowed in the ring.

***Agility Sweepstakes*Friday, July 30th, 2010 at the show site: 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm.**

STEEPLECHASE Style Course. Two runs for \$22. Pre-registered entries will get first consideration. Limited entry of 100 dogs only.

PLEASE NOTE, the last registration will be accepted at 5:00 pm

Sweepstakes is open to All Breeds and Mixed Breeds 12 months of age or older.

The first 7 minutes of each hour will be used for walk throughs, after which, dogs will run small to tall. Dogs must run individual runs in a separate hour grouping (eg. first run in 3 pm group, second run in 4 pm group).

The following heights, in inches, will be provided: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24. Dogs that jump their normal CKC jump height are assessed zero faults. Dogs that jump lower than then their normal CKC jump height, are assessed 10 faults per lower jump height. NO faults are assessed for dogs jumping higher than their eligible CKC jump height.

Scores are based on dog's time plus 5 faults for each of these infractions as they occur: refusal, wrong course, dropped bar, missed contact, each occurrence of training in the ring.

Toys and gentle leading of dogs by their collar may be used during the sweepstakes run, which is considered training in the ring. Please, NO FOOD as the ring will be used for the trial the next day.

All dogs are assessed on their COMBINED score from two runs. Each dog may only run twice in the sweepstakes

The sweepstakes may be used for TRAINING!!! So please feel free to train in the ring, it is entirely up to you!!!

Division of entry money as prizes

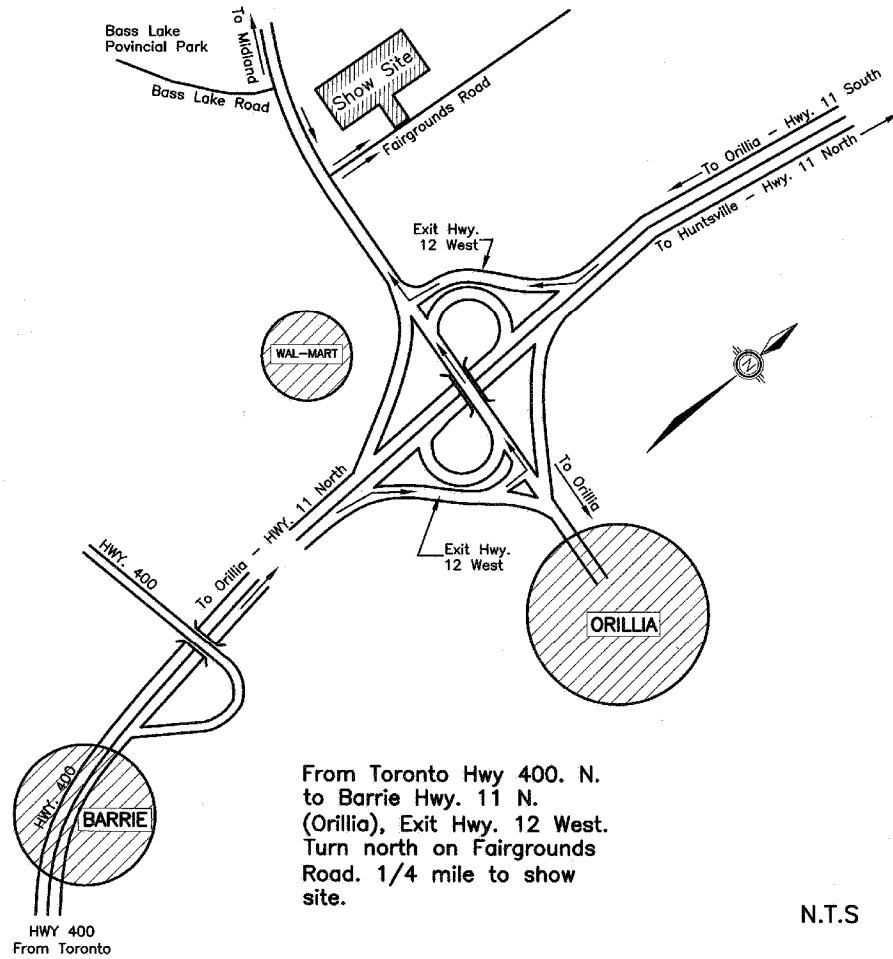

Directions to ODAS Park:

From Toronto: From Hwy 401, take Hwy 400 North past Barrie. Continue onto Hwy 11 North bound. Once in Orillia turn Left at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.

From the North: Travel South on Hwy 11. Once in Orillia turn Right at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) and go 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.



Please read the following rules:

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! These events are team sports. So please leave prong and e-collars and other correction gear at home.
