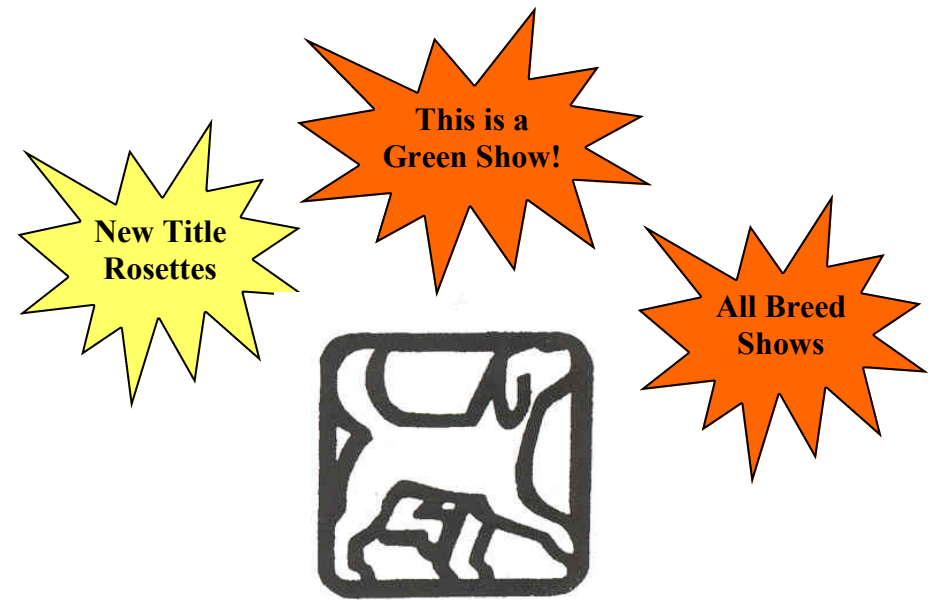

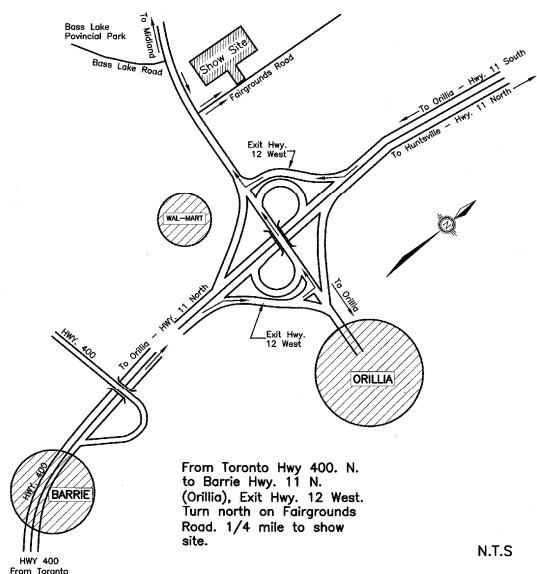

Directions to ODAS Park:

From Toronto: From Hwy 401, take Hwy 400 North past Barrie. Continue onto Hwy 11 North bound. Once in Orillia turn Left at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.

From the North: Travel South on Hwy 11. Once in Orillia turn Right at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) and go 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.



Veteran Classes (affective January 1, 2010):

8.5.1 At the option of the handler, a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Any new titles earned will be designated with the letter 'V' for Veteran following the title (e.g. AGMXV).

8.5.2 All veterans will compete as if running in the Selected Classes at one or two jump heights lower than regular and with the 10% additional time allocated for the Selected Class.

8.5.3 Veterans Classes run the same courses as the Regular and Selected Classes and dogs entered in these classes run concurrently in the respective jump heights.

Moving up in Agility

Move-ups for Trial 1 will be accepted no later than 72 hours prior to Trial 1. For Trials 2 through 4 move ups will be accepted no later then 15 minutes after the RUN that title was completed in is finished.

Moving Up in Obedience

6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

Moving Up in Rally Obedience

6.8.1 A dog that has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the rally obedience rules but at the time of the closing of entries for the trial has not received confirmation of the title may be moved to the next level of competition providing the request is submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler a minimum of one hour before the opening of the first trial on that day, schedule permitting.

	** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Obedience Classes:

(Although adapted from the CKC Obedience Rules and Regulations,
this list is a summary which is not meant to replace reading of the CKC Obedience Rules & Regulations)

Regular & Transition Classes (each dog may enter only 1 of these classes at each trial):

Novice A– only 1 dog per handler in this class, and handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family. This class is not for professional handlers, trainers or persons who have exhibited a dog to its UD. Dogs in this class may not have earned a title in a comparable class in any other county.

Novice B– for handlers or dogs who do meet requirements for Novice A, however dogs who have attained a CD must move to Novice C.

Open A & B- please see Rules and Regulations

Utility – please see Rules and Regulations

Pre-Novice– for dogs who have not earned a CD title in any county (not included in HIT).

Exhibition Only– an official class for dogs NOT entered in a regular class, however dogs in non-regular classes or dogs that are not exhibiting at the trials MUST be entered in this class.

Unofficial Classes:

Dogs may enter more than 1 of these classes. ALL dogs entered in Unofficial Classes MUST be entered in exhibition only or an Official Class, regular or transition in these obedience, rally or agility trials. Scores from these classes are not included in HIT.

Graduate Novice- is open to any dog who has attained a CD, but has not gained a qualifying score towards a CDX title in Canada.

Graduate Open– is open to any dog who has attained a CDX, but has not gained a qualifying score towards the UD title in Canada.

General Information	The Trial Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of 30 feet around the agility ring area and the entire obedience/rally building. Food and toys are not permitted in the rings and no one is permitted to bench or use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the rings. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted in performance area. Dogs must be ON LEASH at all times except in the rings. PLEASE STOOP TO SCOOP!
Agility Information	Agility ring surface is grass. The ring will be enclosed with fencing on four sides and 2 openings. There is no cover/shade available. Handlers in all agility classes will be able to walk their course, without their dog prior to the start of the class. Electronic timing will be used. Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent. Obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization.
Agility Obstacles	Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2010.
Agility Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in the agility trials, a dog must be 18 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Obedience & Rally Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in the obedience or rally trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season <u>may not compete</u> . When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given. However, if a credit card was used, the processing fee will not be refunded.
Trophies	Ribbons will be given for 1st through 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights in Agility trials and in all classes in Obedience and Rally Obedience. New title rosettes will be offered for agility, obedience and rally obedience. There will be supported entry agility, obedience & rally obedience on Sunday, August 1st for Rottweilers and Shetland Sheepdogs. For more information please see page 10.
