

***Judging Schedule for the CKC Agility Team Canada/  
Belleville & District Kennel Club  
July 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>t</sup>, 2010 CKC Agility Trials.***

Classes will run 4” and up on Saturday and 24” down on Sunday. Selected and Veteran classes run concurrently with the regular classes.

*Check in anytime prior to your first course of the weekend. Only check in once. **ALL those who entered online MUST sign a waiver at check in!***

*General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.*

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice dogs only immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run over 2 hours longer!!!

All Breeds and Mixed Breeds are welcome. Entries for each class close 5 minutes after the last dog in the regular trial runs on that day.

From the 401

# 401 to # 6 north, through Guelph. Turn left onto # 7 (Woodlawn Rd.)

At the lights at the car dealerships, turn right onto Regional Rd. # 86 (Elmira Road)

Go through 2 sets of lights in the country. Next road turn right onto 8th Line. At the 3rd road turn right onto Sideroad 12 - we are 1st place on the left (yellow barns). Drive in the driveway, go past the house & yellow barns, follow driveway to parking lot and agility field.

From Fergus:

# 6 towards Guelph. Take 1st right onto the 2nd Line (Stone Retailer). Go to the end and turn left onto

Wellington Rd. # 7 (Elora Rd.). Take the first road right (Sideroad 10). Take the 3rd road left (6th

Line). Take the 1st road right (Sideroad 12). We are the 1st place on the right. Pull in the driveway, go past the house and yellow barns, follow driveway around to parking lot and agility field.

**Please read the following rules:**

**In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:**

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring. Be ready to run your dog with leash off at the point on the course that the judge requests. This is when the dog ahead of you is running! If everyone is 1 minute late in running their dog, that adds almost 2 hours to the trials! Three dogs should be ready to run at all times.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave choke chains, prong collars and other correction gear at home.
