Agility Trials:

Classes will run 4” and up on Wednesday and 24” down on Thursday. Selected class runs concurrently with their regular class.

*Check in will be between 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm Tuesday and 7:30 to 8:30 am Wednesday & Thursday. Only check in once. General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below. Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for **Novice dogs only** immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Wednesday may participate in the Thursday familiarization. PLEASE have you dog with you at the briefing.*

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run an hour longer!!! If you have a conflict between agility and conformation, please let us know and we will do whatever we can to let you and your dog run (we can not however hold up a course change).

A Standard course is offered, nested with both Novice and Excellent. Both levels run at the same time. Walk throughs will happen several times. \$10.00 per entry, or 2 runs with same dog for \$16. PLEASE, no food in the ring as this is the ring we will be using for the trials the next day! Toys and leashes allowed.

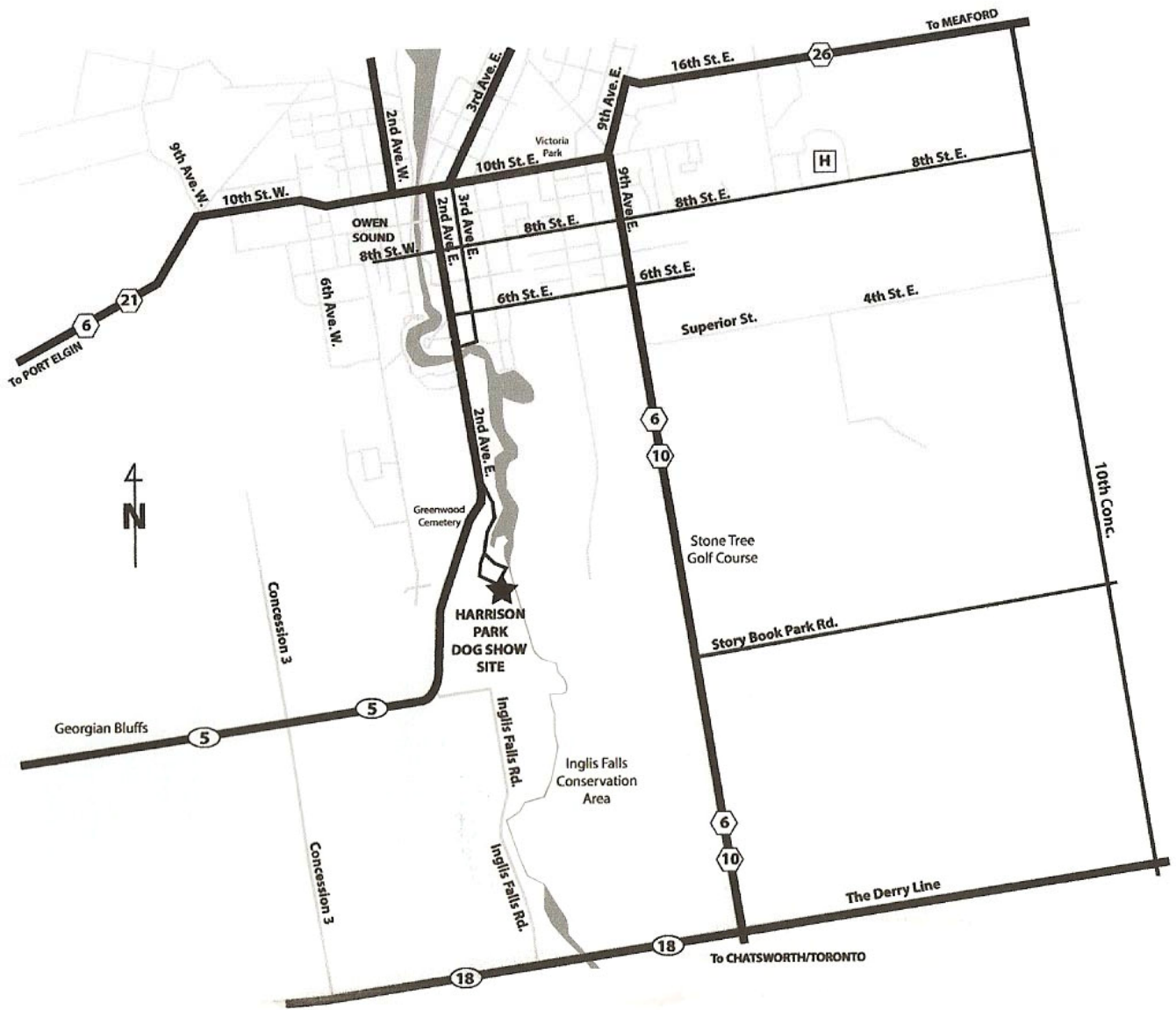

Directions to Harrison Park:

From Hwy 400 (Barrie): Exit Hwy 400 at Bayfield. Turn right on Bayfield St. Turn left at Hwy 26. Continue on Hwy 26 to Owen Sound. Turn left at 9th Ave E. Slight left to stay on 9th Ave E. Turn right at 10th St E. Turn left at 2nd Ave E.

From the 401 (Mississauga): Leave Hwy 401 at exit 344 Hwy 410 northbound, Take the Bovaird Dr. exit toward Hwy 7. Turn left at Bovaird Dr E. Turn right at Hurontario St/ Hwy 10. Continue to follow Hwy 10. Turn left at Hwy 89. Turn right at Hwy 10/Owen Sound St. and follow Hwy 10. Turn left at 6th St E. Continue straight to stay on 6th St E. Turn left at 2nd Ave E



Please read the following rules:

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring. Be ready to run your dog with leash off at the point on the course that the judge requests. This is when the dog ahead of you is running! If everyone is 1 minute late in running their dog, that adds almost 2 hours to the trials! Three dogs should be ready to run at all times.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave choke e-collars, prong collars and other correction gear at home.
