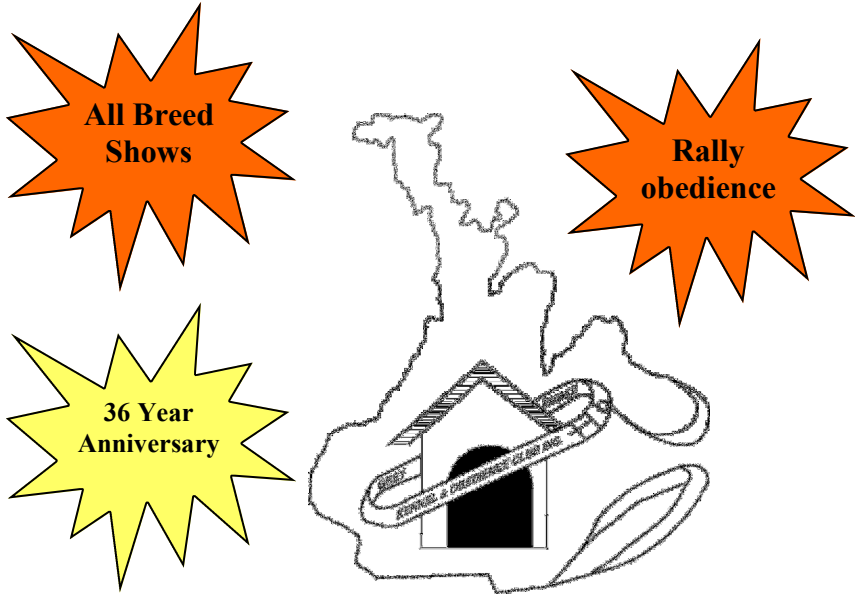

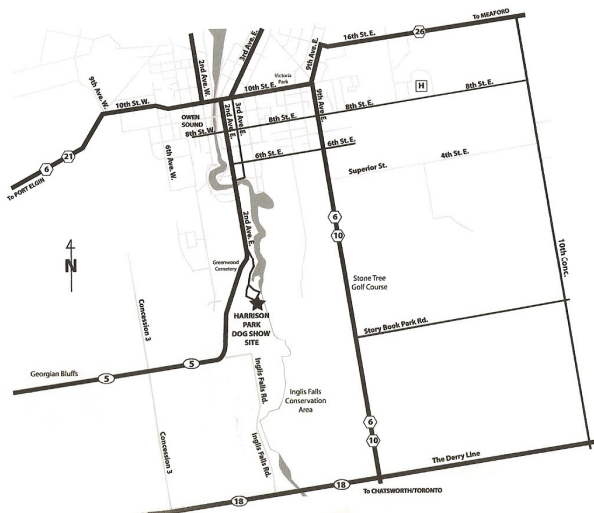

	** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

General Information	The Trial Secretary and Superintendent are in full charge of the trials. The show precincts shall consist of 30 feet around the ring area. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted within 30 feet of ring area. Dogs <u>must</u> be ON LEASH at all times when outside the rings.
Event Information	Ring Surface is grass. The ring will be enclosed with fencing on four sides and 2 openings. There is some cover/shade available. Handlers in all classes will be able to walk their course, without their dog prior to the start of the class. Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent. <b>Obstacle familiarization</b> will be available for Novice classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Wednesday may participate in the Thursday familiarization.
Obstacles	Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2010.
Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 mos. of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.
Trophies	Ribbons will be given for 1st through 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights. New title rosettes are also being offered.

## HELP WANTED

Without the help from volunteers, we could not host these trials. We cannot do it alone! We need your help to make our trial a success. PLEASE sign up to work at the registration desk at the trials.

### **Job Descriptions**

**Gate Steward:** Makes sure exhibitors are at the gate, in the correct order and ready to run

**Ring Steward:** Sets bars to correct positions prior to each jump height in a class. Re-sets dropped bars, straightens chute

**Leash Runner:** Takes exhibitor's leash from start line and places it at finish

**Scribe:** Marks faults on scribe sheet as they are called by the judge

**Timer:** Times the dogs' runs using a stopwatch

**Combiner (will be used if trials are very large):** Hands scribe correct scribe sheet, writes time on scribe sheet, clears stopwatch for timer, hands sheet to sheet runner.

**Course Builder:** Assists the Chief Course Builder with putting obstacles in the correct position as indicated by the judge

**\* There will be a volunteer raffle at the end of each day\***

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## **Are you in the correct Class?**

**Selected Class:** Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class but can not be entered in the Selected Class and Regular Class at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Selected Class must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice level. When entering this class your dog will jump one jump height lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time. For full rules on the Selected Class please refer to the Official CKC Agility rule book.

**Please note:** Novice JWW will have one set of 6 weave poles used once.

**Novice A** is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.

**Novice B** is for agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

**Excellent A** is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

**Excellent B** is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Excellent B in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in.

A dog only needs to be entered in Excellent B for the class that he/she has achieved the excellent title in. ie. A dog can be in Excellent A JWW and Excellent B Standard.

## Judges' Profiles

### **Sandra Esford**

I have been raising and training Golden Retrievers with my husband, Steve, under the Goldencol prefix, for 30 years. We have been active in field work, obedience conformation and agility trialing with our dogs. However, agility has taken most of my interest for the past thirteen years. ### **Billie McLean**

I started my agility career in 1994. I have competed with 2 large, 2 medium and 2 small dogs. Four have achieved their AtchC titles in the AAC organization. I am currently working on our AG.MX with my one toller and Intermediate with my younger one. I became an AAC agility judge in 2002. I upgraded to a Master AAC judge in 2005. I have competed at the AAC Nationals since the beginning in 2001 with my miniature schnauzer Zoe. We have won the National title in the 6" veterans division 3 times. I enjoy competing in and judging agility as well as meeting people from all over our country who share the same enthusiasm for agility as I do.

### **Veteran Classes (effective January 1, 2010):**

8.5.1 At the option of the handler, a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Any new titles earned will be designated with the letter 'V' for Veteran following the title (e.g. AGMXV).

8.5.2 All veterans will compete as if running in the Selected Classes at one or two jump heights lower than regular and with the 10% additional time allocated for the Selected Class.

8.5.3 Veterans Classes run the same courses as the Regular and Selected Classes and dogs entered in these classes run concurrently in the respective jump heights.
