

Judging Schedule for the Ontario NSDTR Club November 20 & 21, 2010 CKC Agility Trials.

Classes will run 4” and up on Saturday and 24” down on Sunday. Selected and Veteran classes runs concurrently with the regular classes.

Check in will be between 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday and anytime prior to your first course of the day Saturday & Sunday. Only check in once. General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below. **ALL those who entered online MUST sign a waiver at check in!**

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for all dogs, all levels from 7:45 am to 8:15 am on both Saturday and Sunday before the trials start. These trials will have 24” spaced weave poles and rubberized contacts and we would like to offer dogs an opportunity to try these pieces out if the owners can not make it to the fun match on Friday. Dogs may only do each piece (weave poles, dog walk, a-frame, teeter and table) once due to time constraints.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run over 3 hours longer!!! *Please email pdca@andrewswireless.net or call Angela Adams 905-985-0748 if you have any questions or concerns.*

Sweepstakes is open to All Breeds and Mixed Breeds 12 months of age or older. Entrants may be shown by owners or agents.

Exhibitors will be allowed 7 minutes to walk the course.

The following heights, in inches, will be provided: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24. Dogs that jump their normal CKC jump height are assessed zero faults. Dogs that jump lower than their normal CKC jump height, are assessed 10 faults per lower jump height. NO faults are assessed for dogs jumping higher than their eligible CKC jump height.

Scores are based on dog's time plus 5 faults for each of these infractions as they occur: refusal, wrong course, dropped bar, missed contact, each occurrence of training in the ring. NO FOOD may be used .

All dogs are assessed on their COMBINED score from two runs. Each dog may only run twice in the sweepstakes.

Division of entry money as prizes

50% of the money will be retained by the club for expenses. The remaining 50% will be divided as follows:

- First.....50%
- Second.....25%
- Third.....10%
- Fourth.....5%

Agility Show-N-Go

Agility Show-N-Go on Friday, November 19th, at the show site. Starts at 3:00 pm, last entries taken at 7:00 pm. **No more new match registrations will be taken after 7:00 pm.** Competitors will be allowed 3 minutes in the ring. Course is Standard, nested with both Novice and Excellent. Both levels run at the same time. Walk throughs will happen at the beginning of each hour. \$10.00 per entry, or 2 runs with same dog for \$16. PLEASE, no food in the ring as this is the ring we will be using for the trials the next day! Toys and leashes allowed. This fun match is for everyone! Mixed breeds, all breeds and un-entered dogs!

Directions to the Royal Canadian Riding Academy:

From the 400

Follow Hwy 400 either north or south to Hwy 9 exit. Follow Hwy 9/ Davis Drive east through Newmarket past the 404. The RCRA is just past the 404 on the north side of the Hwy.

From the 401:

Take the 404 exit northbound. Follow the 404 north until Hwy 9/Davis Drive exit. Turn east, the RCRA is on the north side of the road.



Please read the following rules:

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring. Be ready to run your dog with leash off at the point on the course that the judge requests. This is when the dog ahead of you is running! If everyone is 1 minute late in running their dog, that adds almost 2 hours to the trials! Three dogs should be ready to run at all times.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave choke chains, prong collars and other correction gear at home.
