### **Agility Trials:**

Classes will run 4' and up on Saturday and 24" down on Sunday. Selected & Veteran class runs concurrently with their regular class.

*Check in will be between 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday and anytime Saturday & Sunday. Only check in once. General briefing, judge's briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.*

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for **Novice dogs only** immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization. PLEASE have your dog **with you** at the briefing.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run an hour longer!!! If you have a conflict between agility, conformation, obedience or rally, please let us know and we will do whatever we can to let you and your dog run (we can not however hold up a course change).

### **Scheduling Conflicts**

If you have a conflict between agility, conformation obedience or rally, please let us know and we will do whatever we can to allow you and your dog run (we can not however hold up a course or class change).

### **Late & FEO entries:**

Late entries will be taken up to one (1) hour before each trial starts. FEO entries are also available (for agility and rally only).

### **Moving Up in Obedience**

6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

### **Moving Up in Rally Obedience**

6.8.1 A dog that has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the rally obedience rules but at the time of the closing of entries for the trial has not received confirmation of the title may be moved to the next level of competition providing the request is submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler a minimum of one hour before the opening of the first trial on that day, schedule permitting.

### **Agility Move-ups**

Move-ups for Trial 1 will be accepted until Tuesday, July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2011. For Trials 2 through 4 move ups will be accepted no later than 15 minutes after the RUN that title was completed in is finished.

### **Ribbons**

Placement ribbons or rosettes are offered for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> qualifying scores. All qualifying scores will receive a ribbon. There will not be official awards presentations for AGILITY; ribbons may be claimed at our Agility Awards table. Please ask for your agility, obedience and rally obedience new title rosette if you earned a title this weekend.

### **Amenities:**

Washrooms are available around the show grounds and in the main building, across from obedience/rally. There is some shade, however exhibitors may want to bring pop-up shelters. There is a food concession and other vendors at the BKOC conformation site. There is also food and other amenities available very close to the show/trial site.

### **Camping**

Obedience exhibitors ONLY will be allowed to bring in their RV's on Thursday afternoon. Please park BEFORE the second gate in parking lot and come and find Danielle or Angela so that we may show you where to set up. We will be either at the agility field or in the obedience building.

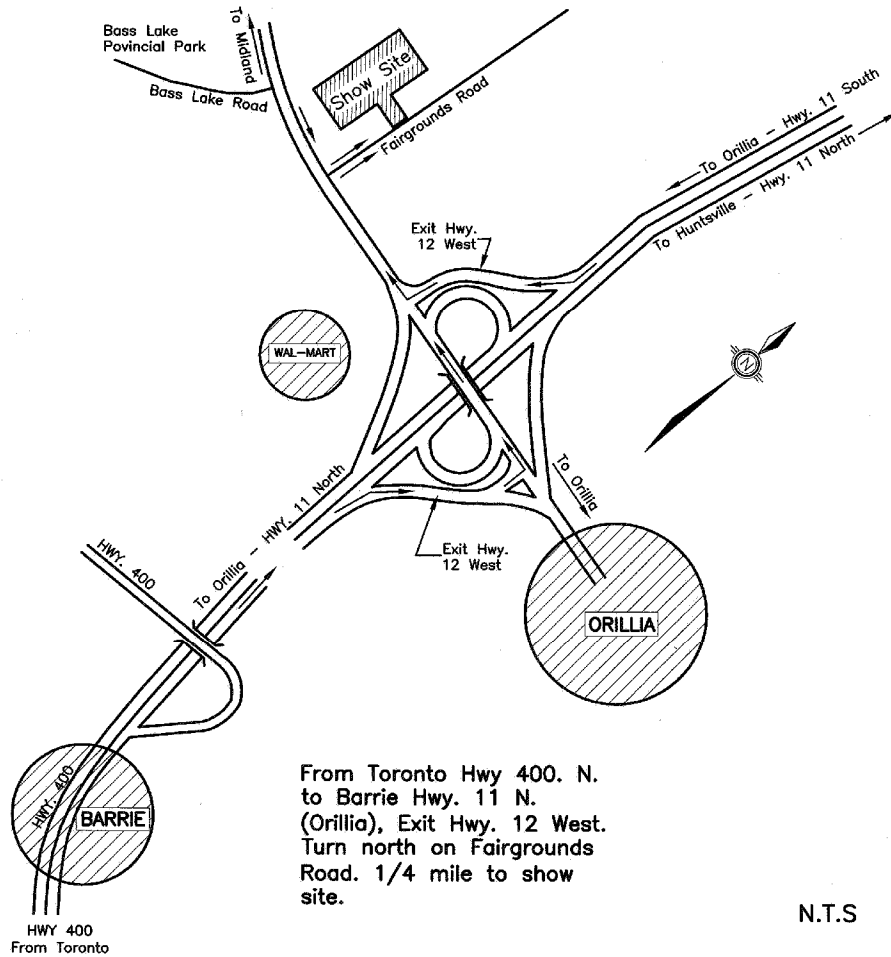

## Directions to ODAS Park:

**From Toronto:** From Hwy 401, take Hwy 400 North past Barrie. Continue onto Hwy 11 North bound. Once in Orillia turn Left at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.

**From the North:** Travel South on Hwy 11. Once in Orillia turn Right at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) and go 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.



**Please read the following rules:**

**In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:**

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! These events are team sports. So please leave prong and e-collars and other correction gear at home.
