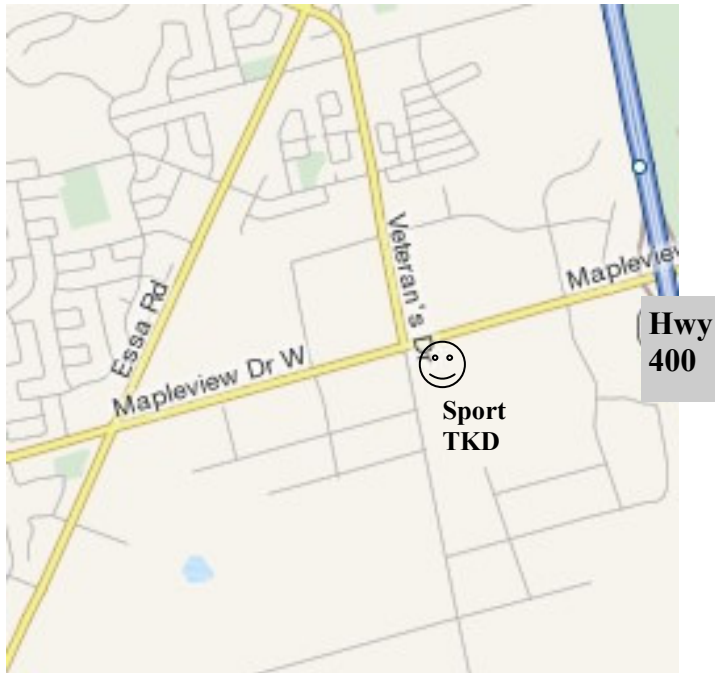

For Exhibition Only Runs (FEO runs)

Under the CKC's new 'show modeling' program, we have permission to offer FEO runs at these trials. No CKC number is needed to take part in FEO runs. CKC will not be tracking these scores, however PDC will track these scores. Qualifying scores from these runs will receive a pink qualifying score ribbon, but they will not be counted towards official CKC titles. Exhibitors may enter FEO runs as many times as they like at a trial. FEO entries MUST be received by the secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to the class you want to run in. PDC reserves the right to refuse an entry and to decide when an FEO entry will run.

Mixed Breed Dogs

Under the CKC's 'show modeling' program, we have been given permission to allow dogs of mixed breed origin to take part in FEO runs. All FEO rules apply to this section as well.

Obedience Classes:

(Although adapted from the CKC Obedience Rules and Regulations, this list is a summary which is not meant to replace reading of the CKC Obedience Rules & Regulations)

Regular & Transition Classes (each dog may enter only 1 of these classes at each trial):
Novice A- only 1 dog per handler in this class, and handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family. This class is not for professional handlers, trainers or persons who have exhibited a dog to its UD. Dogs in this class may not have earned a title in a comparable class in any other county.

Novice B- for handlers or dogs who do meet requirements for Novice A, however dogs who have attained a CD must move to Novice C.

Open A & B and Utility- please see Rules and Regulations

Pre-Novice- for dogs who have not earned a CD title in any county (not included in HIT).

Novice-Intermediate- for dogs that have earned a CD title and any other advanced obedience title in Canada. (not included in HIT)

Exhibition Only- an official class for dogs NOT entered in a regular class, however dogs in non-regular classes or dogs that are not exhibiting at the trials MUST be entered in this class.

Performance Liability Agreement (MUST accompany all entries)

I (we) acknowledge that Barrie Kennel and Obedience Club Inc. & Performance Dogs Canada has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of these trials and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this obedience trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

	<p style="text-align: center;">Non-member participation fee</p> a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."
	The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is: \$55.00 + HST

General Information	The trial Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of the entire obedience building. Food and toys are not permitted in the rings and no one is permitted to bench or use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the rings. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted in building. Dogs <u>must</u> be ON LEASH at all times outside the building. PLEASE STOOP TO SCOOP! This building is NOT normally used for canine events, so we MUST respect their grounds. No exercise pens will be allowed.
Obedience Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in the obedience trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season <u>may not compete</u> . When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given. However, if a credit card was used, the processing fee will not be refunded.
Trophies	Ribbons will be given for qualifying scores and rosettes for 1st through 4th qualifying scores in all classes.
Food Concession	No food will be available for purchase at the trial site, but there are plenty of options close by.
Moving Up	6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.
