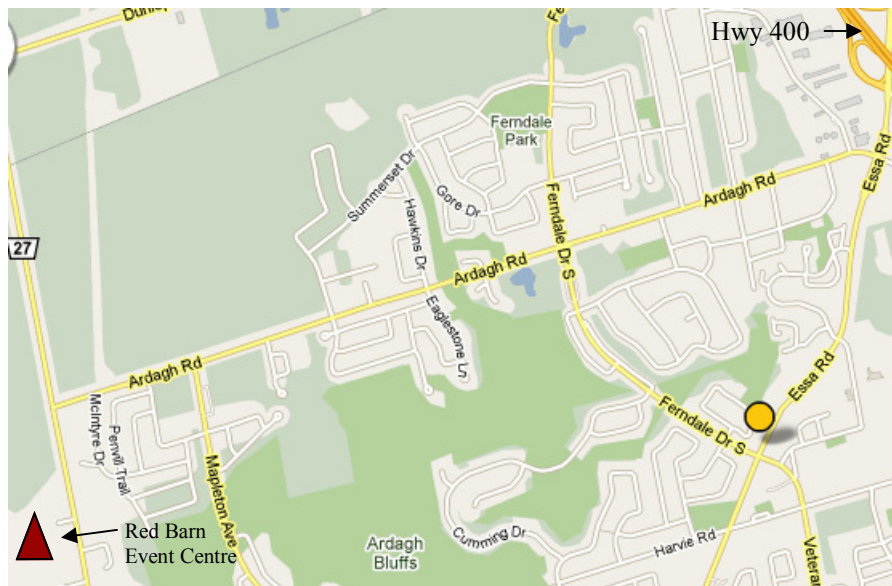

In 2010 the Board of Directors passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members.

At the December 2010 Board of Directors meeting the Tracking Fee motion was deleted and replaced with the following motion:

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011.

	** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred..

General Information	The Trial Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of the indoor arena area. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted in the arena, parking lot or anywhere on the RBEC property. Dogs <u>must</u> be ON LEASH at all times when outside the ring.
Event Information	Ring Surface is dirt. The ring is FULLY fenced with orange snow fencing. Benching is also available in a separate area from the rings. Handlers in all classes will be able to walk their course for 7 minutes only, without their dog prior to the start of the class. Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent. Obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization.
Obstacles	Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2010. Please note, there are several changes and exhibitors are advised to read the new rulebook to become aware of them.
Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 mos. of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.
Trophies	Ribbons will be given for 1st through 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights. New Title Rosettes will be offered.
Food Concession	Lunch will be provided for volunteers. There are also several fast food and sit down restaurants within a five minute drive.

Move-ups will be allowed after the closing date. For Trial 1 move-ups must be received by the trial secretary no later than 72 hours prior to the trial. For all other trials move-ups must be received a minimum of 15 minutes after the class the title was completed in.

Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except as noted in this premium list. **The ONLY exception is bitches in season. Unfortunately we can not refund any entries, after closing, for injured dogs or any other reason.**

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.

Judging schedules will be mailed or emailed as soon as possible after the closing date. They will also be posted on our website.

Tendering of NSF cheque is considered as non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$40.00 service charge.

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, in US funds. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

Foreign Exhibitors

HELP WANTED

Job Descriptions

Gate Steward: Makes sure exhibitors are at the gate, in the correct order and ready to run

Ring Steward: Sets bars to correct positions prior to each jump height in a class. Re-sets dropped bars, straightens chute

Leash Runner: Takes exhibitor's leash from start line and places it at finish

Scribe: Marks faults on scribe sheet as they are called by the judge

Timer: Times the dogs' runs using electronic timing.

Scribe Assistant (will be used if trials are very large): Hands scribe correct scribe sheet, writes time on scribe sheet, and hands sheet to sheet runner.

Course Builder: Assists the Chief Course Builder with putting obstacles in the correct position as indicated by the judge

Food will be provided for all those who work.

A volunteer raffle will be held at the end of each day.

Are you in the correct Class?

Selected Class: Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class but can not be entered in the Selected Class and Regular Class at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Selected Class must progress through the various levels beginning with the Novice level. Dogs will jump one jump height lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time.

Novice A is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.

Novice B is for agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Excellent A is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

Excellent B is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Excellent B in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in. A dog only needs to be entered in Excellent B for the class that he/she has achieved the excellent title in. ie. A dog can be in Excellent A JWW and Excellent B Standard.

Veteran Class: a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one or two jump heights lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time. For full rules on these classes please refer to the Official CKC Agility rule & regulations.

For Exhibition Only Runs (FEO runs)

Under the CKC's new 'show modeling' program, we have been given permission to offer FEO runs at these trials. No CKC number is needed to take part in FEO runs. CKC will not be tracking these scores, however PDC will track these scores. Qualifying scores from these runs will receive a pink qualifying score ribbon, but they will not be counted towards official CKC titles. Exhibitors may enter FEO runs as many times as they like at a trial, at any level they like, provided they offer evidence to PDC that a dog will have success at that level (eg. The dog runs masters in AAC and a person would like to run excellent in CKC). It is recommended, however, that dogs start at the Novice level and progress through the classes for future PDC award recognition. FEO entries MUST be received by the secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to the class you want to run in. FEO runs will run at the end of the jump heights within the correct class.

Judges' Profiles

Roger-Pierre Cote:

Roger-Pierre started competitive obedience in 1990 with a German Shepherd, and got involved with agility in 1992. He and his wife learned agility from a book from France and were introduced to AAC agility in 1993. He helped create several Quebec agility clubs and became a judge in 1998. Since then, Roger-Pierre has judged across Canada from Halifax to Vancouver and agility has become almost a religion in him and wife Lucie Dessureault. Now in 2009, the house, cars, vacation, spare time and everything in their life relates to dog sports. They have four dogs, a Belgian Gronendael 'Twister', a Belgian Tervuren 'C-4' and two Shelties 'Nitro' and 'Scud'. Their life now is agility, obedience, skijoring, sledding, rally-o, water jumping and anything that involve their dogs.

Danielle LeVangie:

I got my start in CKC events almost 20 years ago with a Dalmatian named Beau. Since that time, I have competed in conformation, obedience, agility, rally, flyball, field trials and road trials in both Canada and the US in a variety of different sanctioning bodies.
