

Judging Schedule for the Golden Retriever Club of Greater Toronto April 30 & May 1, 2011 CKC Agility Trials.

Classes will run 4” and up on Saturday and 24” down on Sunday. Selected and Veteran classes runs concurrently with the regular classes. FEO runs after Veterans in their appropriate class.

*Check in will be between 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday and anytime prior to your first course of the day Saturday & Sunday. Only check in once. **ALL those who entered online MUST sign a waiver at check in!** General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.*

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice dogs only immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run over 2 hours longer!!!

PLEASE NOTE: late entries are accepted up to one (1) hour before each trial starts and FEO runs are accepted up to 15 minutes before that class starts, therefore entry numbers may change slightly.

Amenities:

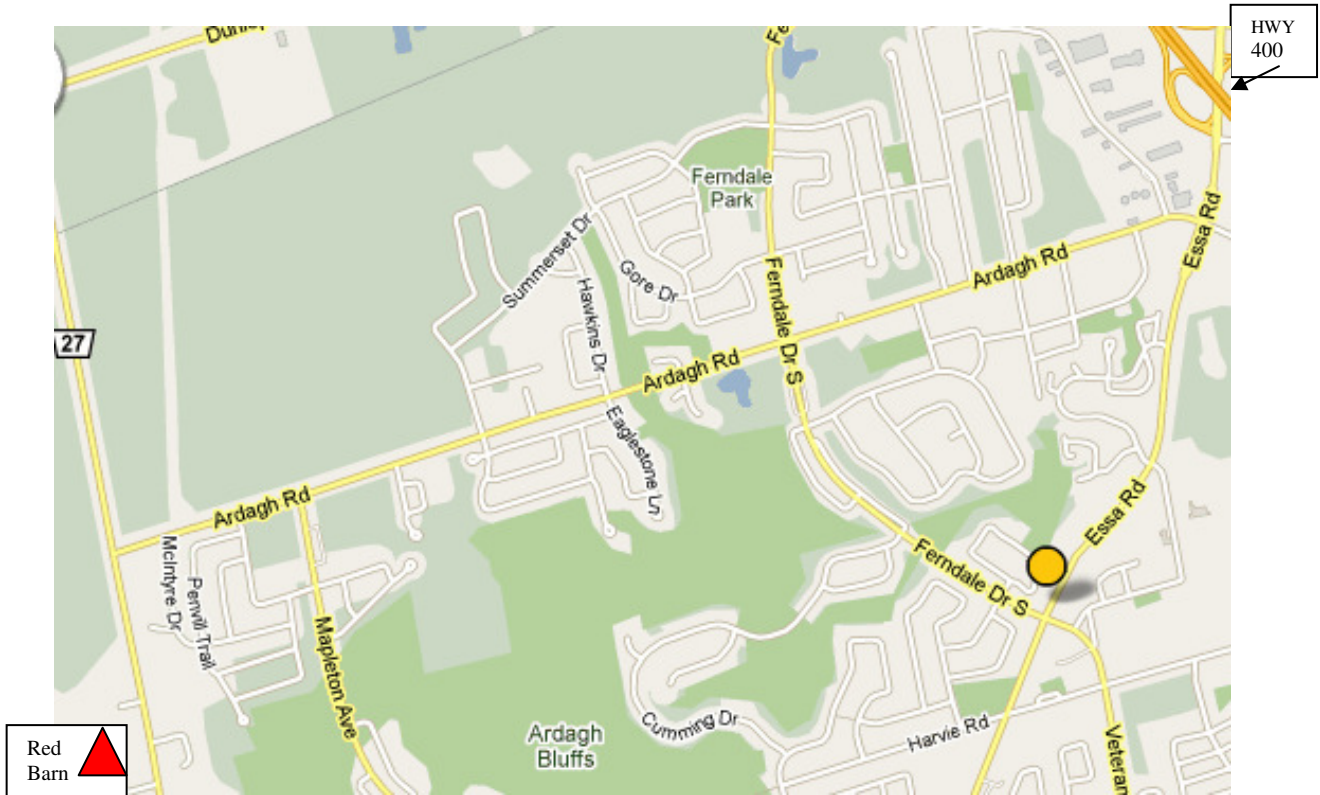
Water and drinks are available for purchase at the trials. There is a GREAT full service café that is 1 minute from the trial site. It is however, NOT open on Sunday.

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa. Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27.(aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.



Please read the following rules:

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- 1) PLEASE drive slowly down the long laneway and do not let you dogs out in the front of the property as this is a private residence!
- 2) Only park in the designated parking area. There will be signage.
- 3) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 4) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 5) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 6) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 7) No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- 8) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 9) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring. Be ready to run your dog with leash off at the point on the course that the judge requests. This is when the dog ahead of you is running! If everyone is 1 minute late in running their dog, that adds almost 2 hours to the trials! Three dogs should be ready to run at all times.**
- 10) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 11) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 12) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave choke chains, prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends!
