

# *Judging Schedule for the German Shepherd Dog Club of Canada Sept. 17 & 18, 2011 CKC Agility Trials.*

**PLEASE NOTE CHANGE TO SURFACE TYPE**

Our rubber has not arrived at the time of this judging schedule release. We will be running **outdoors in a grassed fully fenced ring. Ring Configuration is still 100 x 80.** Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Classes will run 4” and up on Saturday and 24” down on Sunday. Selected & veteran classes run concurrently with their regular class.

Check in will be between 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday or **prior to your first run** on Saturday & Sunday. Only check in once. General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice dogs only immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization. **PLEASE** have your dog with you at the briefing.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run an hour longer!!!

### **Agility Show-N-Go**

Agility Show-N-Go on Friday, September 16, at the show site from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. **No more new match registrations will be taken after 6:30 pm.** Competitors will be allowed 3 minutes in the ring. Course is Jumpers with Weaves, nested with both Novice and Excellent. Both levels run at the same time. Walk throughs will happen at the beginning of each hour. \$10.00 per entry, or 2 runs with same dog for \$16. PLEASE, no food in the ring as this is the ring we will be using for the trials the next day! Toys and leashes allowed. **CONTACT EQUIPMENT** will be available and ALL competitors entered in the Agility Show & Go are welcome to try it out at their leisure at no extra cost between 3:00 pm and 7:00 pm on Friday, Sept. 16th.

### **Prizes, Ribbons & New Title Rosettes**

We are offering placement ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> qualifying scores. Don't forget to get your GSDCC new title rosette at our trials. There will not be official awards presentations. Ribbons and prizes may be claimed at our Awards table. Those that do not want their ribbons now have the option of taking the stickers only.

### **Amenities:**

There is plenty of shade around the outdoor ring and shade tents are welcome. There is one portable toilet on site and no running water yet. Our bathrooms will be in during the month of October. There is no food for sale at the show site, but there is a great café close by and other fast food options a short drive away. You are welcome to crate indoors whether we are playing indoors or not.

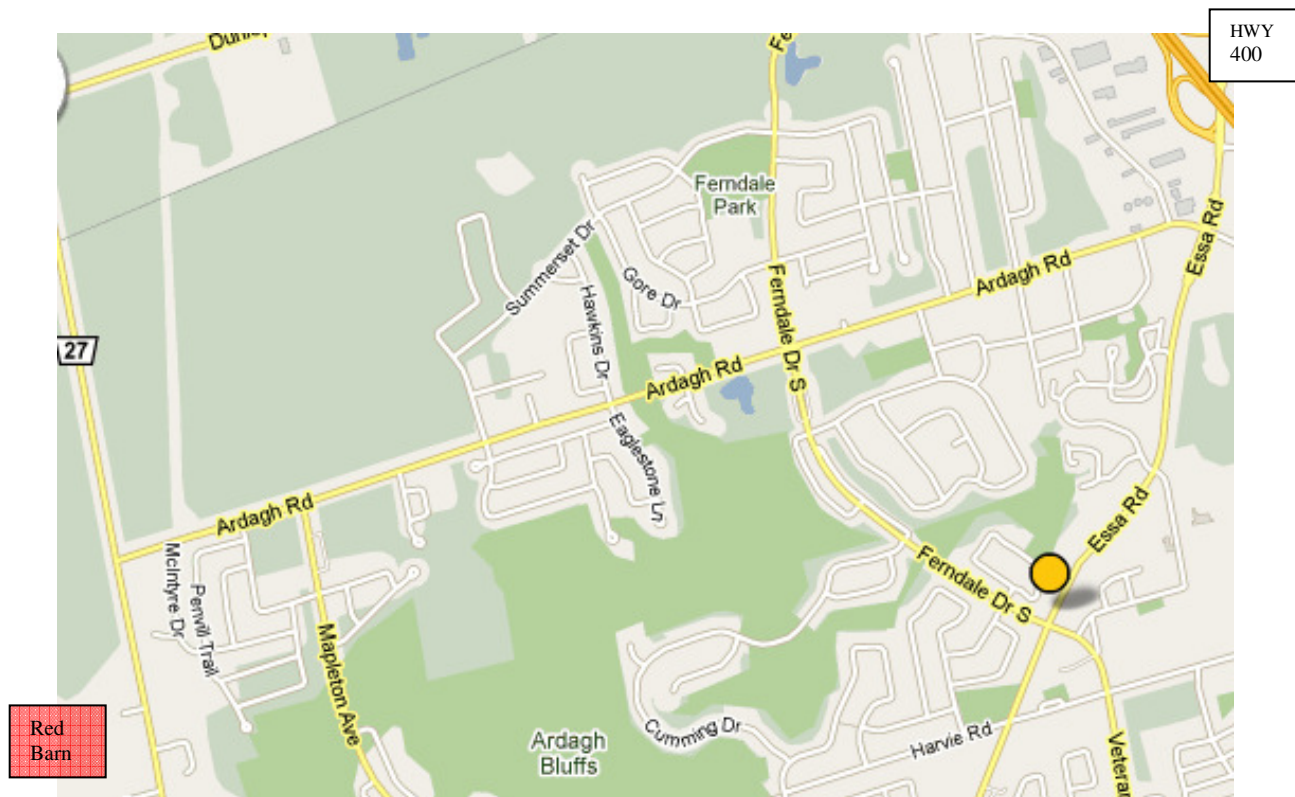
### **Camping:**

On site camping is available. 15 amp service is \$15 per night (please bring cash). No water is available this year. PLEASE reserve ahead of time so we know what to expect. Most campers will be on sand surface, so do bring a grass mat for outside your trailer or under xpens. Also, some campers may be a ways from your plug in, so bring an extension cord for your RV. You are welcome to camp in grassy area at the back of the property if you have a generator.

### Directions to The Red Barn Event Centre:

**From the 400:** Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27.(aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

**From Hwy 27:** When traveling North on CR 27 you must turn left shortly after passing through the town of Thornton. Look for the 20<sup>th</sup> Sideroad on your left and then the 10<sup>th</sup> Line on your right, that's your cue to slow down. Then you will see a small sign on your right that shows you must turn left to stay on CR 27. Turn left on CR 27 and continue north. After passing Mapleview Dr. W. you will go down a big hill, the Red Barn flags are on your left at the bottom of that hill.



**Please read the following rules:**

**In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:**

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum. Please do not park in the laneway spots under the trees and crate in your van if your dogs are going to bark, our neighbours do not appreciate that. Please park at the back, by the Red Barn if you dogs are barkers.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring. Be ready to run your dog with leash off at the point on the course that the judge requests. This is when the dog ahead of you is running! If everyone is 1 minute late in running their dog, that adds almost 2 hours to the trials! Three dogs should be ready to run at all times.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home.
