Late entries will be taken up to one (1) hour before each trial starts. FEO entries are also available (for agility and rally only).

Moving Up in Obedience

6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

Ribbons

Placement rosettes are offered for 1st through 4th qualifying scores. All qualifying scores will receive a rosette.

Amenities:

Washrooms are available around the show grounds and in the main building, across from obedience/rally. There is some shade, however exhibitors may want to bring pop-up shelters. There is a food concession and other vendors at the BKOC conformation site. There is also food and other amenities available very close to the show/trial site.

***2 Rally Obedience Sanction Matches* offered by Simcoe Performance Dogs**

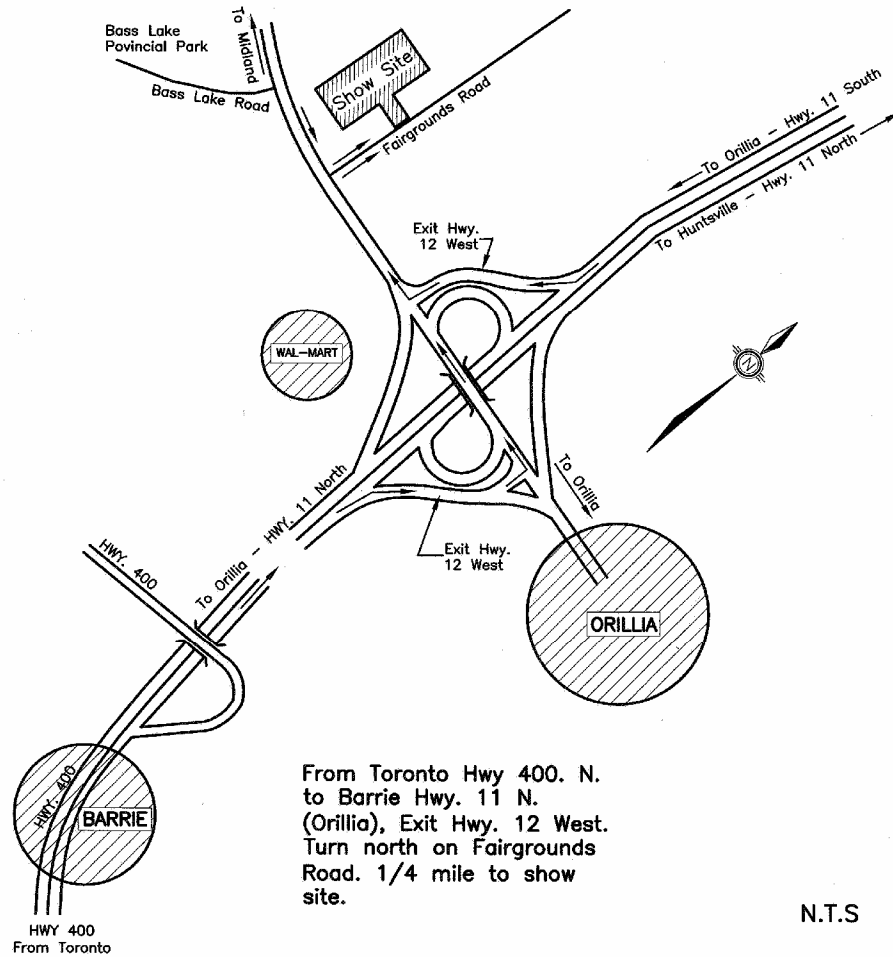
Saturday, July 30th at the show site: 6:00 pm until finished. \$10 per entry or two runs for \$16.

Directions to ODAS Park:

From Toronto: From Hwy 401, take Hwy 400 North past Barrie. Continue onto Hwy 11 North bound. Once in Orillia turn Left at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.

From the North: Travel South on Hwy 11. Once in Orillia turn Right at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) and go 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.

Please read the following rules:

In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! These events are team sports. So please leave prong and e-collars and other correction gear at home.
