No entries will be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time, for entries, except for as provided in the rules.

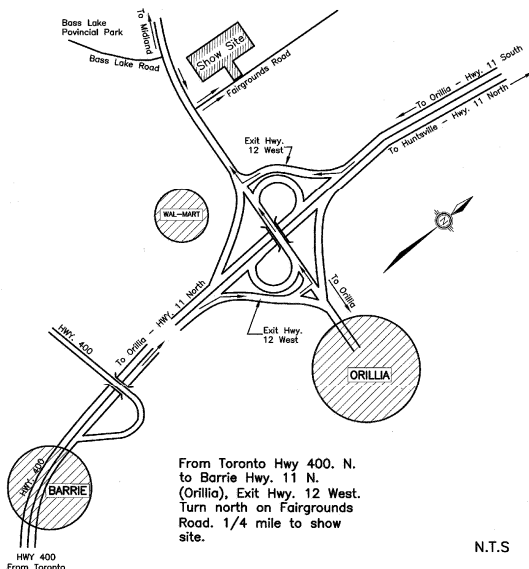

These events are held under the rules of the "Canadian Kennel Club".

### Directions to ODAS Park:

**From Toronto:** From Hwy 401, take Hwy 400 North past Barrie. Continue onto Hwy 11 North bound. Once in Orillia turn Left at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.

**From the North:** Travel South on Hwy 11. Once in Orillia turn Right at Hwy 12 (Coldwater Rd) and go 1.6 km. Turn Right at Fairgrounds Road.



**Regular & Transition Classes (each dog may enter only 1 of these classes at each trial):**  
**Novice A-** only 1 dog per handler in this class, and handler must be owner, co-owner or immediate family. This class is not for professional handlers, trainers or persons who have exhibited a dog to its UD. Dogs in this class may not have earned a title in a comparable class in any other county.

**Novice B-** for handlers or dogs who do meet requirements for Novice A, however dogs who have attained a CD must move to Novice C.

**Open A & B and Utility-** please see Rules and Regulations

**Pre-Novice-** for dogs who have not earned a CD title in any county (not included in HIT).

**Novice-Intermediate-** for dogs that have earned a CD title and any other advanced obedience title in Canada. (not included in HIT)

**Veteran Class -** for dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years or older on the day of the trials. Exercises are that of the novice class. Dogs entered in Veterans MUST be entered in a regular class of for exhibition only.

**Exhibition Only-** an official class for dogs NOT entered in a regular class, however dogs in non-regular classes or dogs that are not exhibiting at the trials MUST be entered in this class.

### Performance Liability Agreement (MUST accompany all entries)

I (we) acknowledge that Labrador Retriever Club of Canada, Labrador Retriever Club of Ontario & Performance Dogs Canada has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of these trials and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to fold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this obedience trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

General Information	The trial Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of the entire obedience building. Food and toys are not permitted in the rings and no one is permitted to bench or use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the rings. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted in building. Dogs <u>must</u> be ON LEASH at all times outside the building. PLEASE STOOP TO SCOOP!
Obedience Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in the obedience trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season <u>may not compete</u> . When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given. However, if a credit card was used, the processing fee will not be refunded.
Trophies	Ribbons will be given for qualifying scores and rosettes for 1st through 4th qualifying scores in all classes. Special prizes will be offered for all placements and High in Trial.
Food Concession	Food will be available for purchase at the trial site.
Moving Up	6.8.2 When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up to, schedule permitting.

Camping	<b>Camping available on site</b> . Camping can be paid with entries, or mail cheque to BKOC c/o P.O.Box 20011, Barrie ON L4M 6E9 in advance, no post dated cheques. \$79.10 includes HST for any portion of the weekend, hydro and water on first come first served basis. There is a \$10 surcharge at the gate if not pre-paid.
Early Bird Discount	<b>We are offering a significant savings off entry fees for our loyal exhibitors who enter these trials two weeks prior to the closing date.</b> Entries <b>MUST</b> be RECEIVED by the secretary on or before Friday, <b>June 24th</b> to qualify for this discount.
Late Entries	NEW!!! Late entries will be accepted up to one hour before each trial starts. Sorry, we can not accept late entries once we have reached seven (7) hours of judging.
