

## Judging Schedule for the Weimaraner Association of Canada June 11 & 12, 2011 CKC Agility Trials.

Classes will run 4” and up on Saturday and 24” down on Sunday. Selected and Veteran classes runs concurrently with the regular classes.

*Check in will be between 2:00 pm to 7:00 pm Friday and anytime prior to your first course of the day Saturday & Sunday. Only check in once. **ALL those who entered online MUST sign a waiver at check in!** General briefing, judge’s briefing and walk through times listed in chart below.*

Contact obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice dogs only immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class of EACH day. Only those dogs who are NOT entered on Saturday may participate in the Sunday familiarization.

Please be at the start line, ready to run at the proper time! The judge (during briefing) and gate steward will let you know when that is. Even a 30 second delay per dog will cause the day to run over an hour longer!!!

**Late Entries & FEO runs:**

NEW!!! Late entries for regular runs will be accepted up to one hour before each trial starts.

FEO runs for purebred and mixed breeds are accepted up to 15 minutes before each class starts!

**Agility Show-N-Gos & Obedience Sanction Match:**

Agility Show-N-Go on Friday, June 10<sup>th</sup>, at the show site from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Competitors will be allowed 3 minutes in the ring. Course is Jumpers with Weaves, nested with both Novice and Excellent. Both levels run at the same time. Walk throughs will happen at the beginning of each hour. \$10.00 per entry, or 2 runs with same dog for \$16. PLEASE, no food in the ring as this is the ring we will be using for the trials the next day! Toys and leashes allowed.

Agility CONTACT EQUIPMENT will be in a separate area and ALL competitors entered in the Agility Show & Go are welcome to try it out at their leisure at no extra cost.

**For Exhibition Only Runs (FEO runs)**

Under the CKC’s new ‘show modeling’ program, we have been given permission to offer FEO runs at these trials. No CKC number is needed to take part in FEO runs. CKC will not be tracking these scores, however PDC will track these scores. Qualifying scores from these runs will receive a pink qualifying score ribbon, but they will not be counted towards official CKC titles. Exhibitors may enter FEO runs as many times as they like at a trial. FEO entries MUST be received by the secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to the class you want to run in. An FEO run will be accepted ONLY if there is room in that class. FEO dogs run after veterans in their jump height.

**Mixed Breed Dogs**

Under the CKC’s ‘show modeling’ program, we have been given permission to allow dogs of mixed breed origin to take part in FEO runs. All FEO rules apply to this section as well.

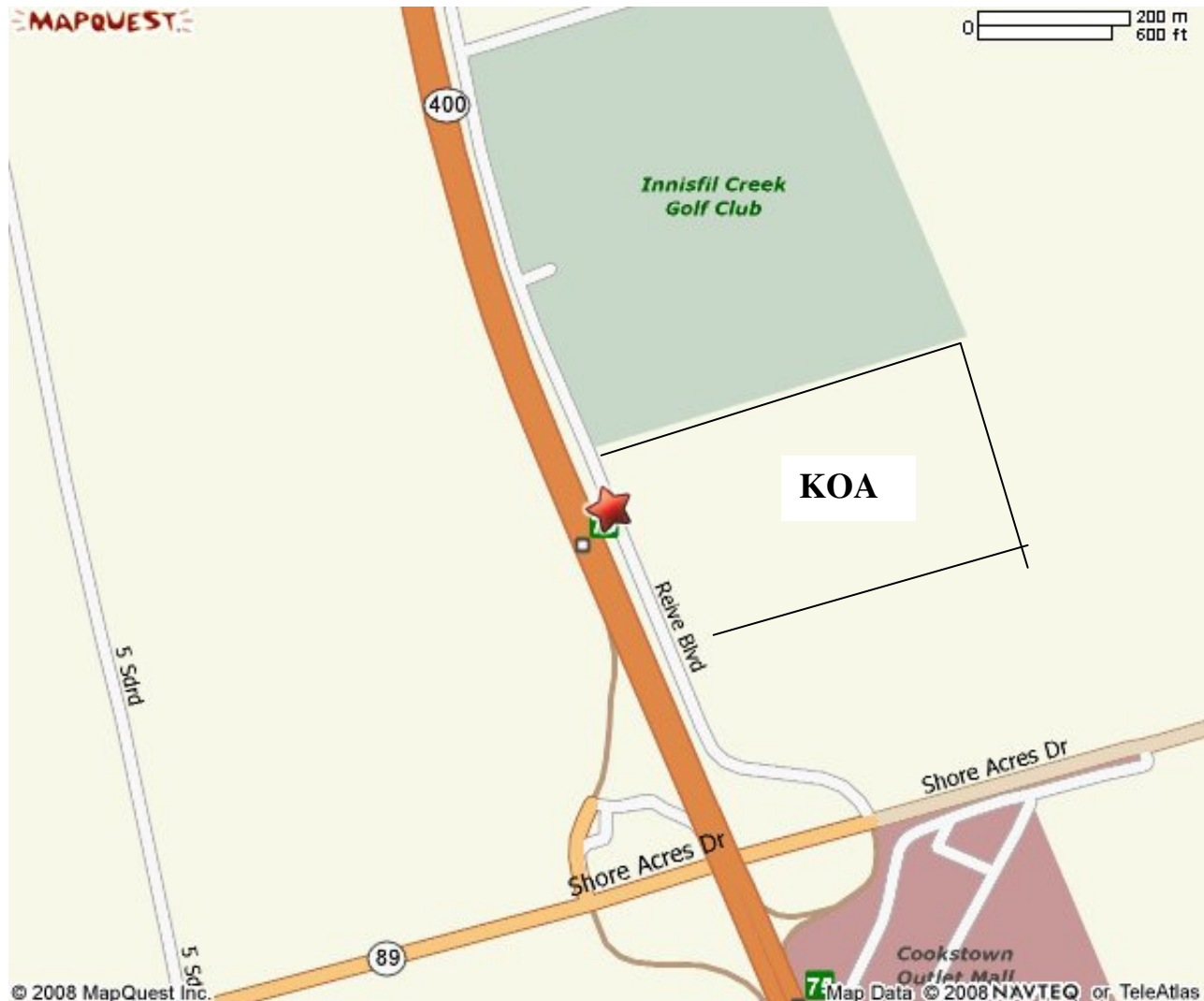

## Directions to Cookstown KOA

**From North :** Take Hwy 400 South to Hwy 89. Go East on Hwy 89. First street on the left, after you cross the Hwy 400 overpass, is Reive Blvd. Go North on Reive Blvd and KOA will be on the East side of the road after less than a minute. The trials will be held on the east side of the very large field south of the campground.

**From South :** Take Hwy 400 North to Hwy 89. Take the Hwy 89 off ramp. Continue north though the off ramp lights onto Reive Blvd. Go North on Reive Blvd and KOA will be on the East side of the road after less than a minute. The trials will be held on the east side of the very large field south of the campground.



## Please read the following rules:

**In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:**

- 1) Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- 2) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.

- 3) Please pick up your dog's waste.
- 4) Please clean up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking on the trial site.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum.
- 7) **Know when you're scheduled to run, check in with the gate steward, and be ready to go when the dog ahead of you is in the ring. Be ready to run your dog with leash off at the point on the course that the judge requests. This is when the dog ahead of you is running! If everyone is 1 minute late in running their dog, that adds almost 3 hours to the trials! Three dogs should be ready to run at all times.**
- 8) Be nice to our judges and ring crew. Remember if you want to be treated with respect, give others the same respect.
- 9) If there is anything we can do to make your trial experience better, please let us know.
- 10) Last but not least, have fun! Agility is a team sport. So please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home.
